'Nobody cares!'

ALEXANDRIA, La. (LBM) — "Nobody cares what's happening to the Uyghurs, okay? You bring it up because you really care, and I think that's nice that you care. The rest of us don't care."

This appalling statement was made by Silicon Valley billionaire Chamath Palihapitiya, founder of Social Capital and a former America OnLine executive, during his podcast on Martin Luther King Jr. Day. He also is part owner of the Warriors franchise of the NBA.

Meanwhile, the ethnic-minority Uyghurs, a mostly Muslim population in Xinjiang Province, are suffering untold horrors at the hands of China's Communist government. According to multiple news reports, the Uyghurs are experiencing:

- slave labor (more than half a million Uyghurs are used to hand pick cotton)
- forced contraception, forced abortions, forced sterilizations (China acknowledged a 60 percent drop in the region's birth rate, 2015-2018, and another 24 percent decline in 2019, but denies forced sterilization; instead,

Woman chooses life, finds hope at CENLA Pregnancy Center

ALEXANDRIA, La. (LBM) — Miranda Underwood walked into the CENLA Pregnancy Center scared and in denial that she was pregnant. But she walked out with hope and a life-giving mindset.

"The first day I found out I was pregnant, abortion crossed my mind, but I knew it was never the right thing to do," Underwood told the *Baptist Message*. "When I walked into the CENLA Pregnancy Center, I was at the darkest moment in my life. But when I left, I knew it would be the greatest moment and everything would be okay."

DISCOVERING HOPE

Underwood was told by others that she would struggle to succeed as a single mother. Unsure where to turn, she reached out to family members, who referred her to the CENLA Pregnancy Center.

She said the February 2020 visit changed her life.

The staff encouraged her and gave her a journal entitled "Hope."

Importantly, they shared a photo of baby Phaelyn that was taken by ultrasound; and she realized at that moment everything would be okay.

"It was a sign from God that this was meant to be," she said. "Everything

Bahamian church campus nearly restored

PELICAN POINT, Bahamas (LBM) — A Louisiana Baptist-led effort to help St. Matthew Baptist

Church rebuild three years after Hurricane Dorian leveled their facility is nearing completion.

According to Stan Statham, Louisiana Baptist Disaster Relief strategist,

90 percent of the work has been completed on the Pelican Point facilities. Remaining work includes installation of doors, air

happens for a reason. “I appreciate what each lady has done, from the smiles to being very sweet to being there for me in my most vulnerable time,” she continued. “The hugs and welcoming feeling you get is rare. It’s genuine love here. Here they want to know how you are doing, still 15 months later.” Throughout her pregnancy, the staff continued to contact Underwood. They

hosted her for motherhood preparedness classes, helped her find a pediatrician and obstetrician-gynecologist, and donated items for her unborn child. For most of the pregnancy, Phaelyn’s father remained uninvolved. However, just before her birth (October 2020) he embraced his role as a father and has remained active in Phaelyn’s life, since. Today, Underwood is thriving as a mother. More-

over, she has a job at the RoyOMartin-Plywood manufacturing facility in Chopin and owns a home and a car. “I wouldn’t take this experience back for anything,” Underwood said. “It’s the best feeling being a mom. I wish everyone could have a kid to have that feeling. It’s more of a blessing than I imagined.”

CONTINUED HOPE

Located on the Louisiana Baptist Building campus, 1254 MacArthur Drive, Alexandria

since December 2017, CENLA Pregnancy Center has served 1,064 women through pregnancy decision coaching (by trained advocates), free pregnancy tests, free ultrasounds, information about pregnancy options and other services.

More than 200 churches of multiple Christian denominations worked together to establish the pregnancy resource center, a non-profit, pro-life organization to provide compassionate support to women and men faced with difficult pregnancy decisions.

First Baptist Church, Pollock, began praying in January 2014 about setting up a pregnancy care center in central Louisiana. By December 2016, a nine-person board of trustees had been formed, with members, then, from Big Creek, Central Louisiana and North Rapides Baptist Associations. Then a \$1 annual lease was signed in 2017 for use of the 5,660-sq.-ft. facility, a \$72,000 annual benefit provided by the Louisiana Baptist Convention.

CENLA Pregnancy Center Executive Director Claire

Lemoine said she is grateful God has allowed her organization to help women like Underwood choose life.

“Miranda showed great courage when she sought out services from us in a moment of much fear and confusion,” Lemoine said. “To know that the ministry was part of she and her Phaelyn’s journey is such a gift to each one of us who labor here.”

SULPHUR, La. (LBM) – For more than a year, Addisyn Brattain had been a faithful attendee of Maplewood First Baptist Church when her student minister, Nathan Yates, challenged the youth group to truly follow Christ.

Brattain knew about Jesus, but it was not until that summertime Wednesday evening that she finally understood what it meant to be committed to Him. During a worship service, Sept. 26, she shared her decision before friends and family through baptism.

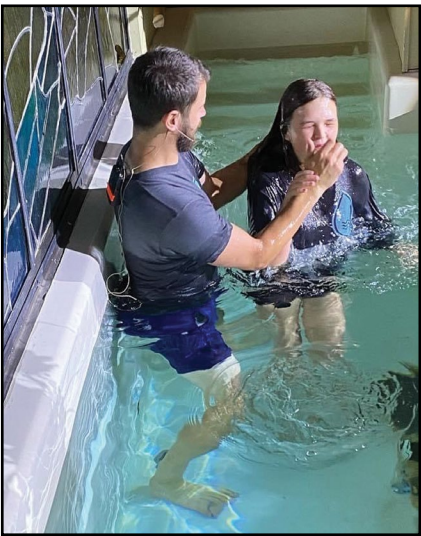
“It was like a breath of fresh air being born again,” Brattain told the *Baptist Message*.

She also said she was excited “to be surrounded by family and friends” to celebrate her baptism.

“I can’t wait to see what plans God has for me in the future,” Brattain added.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

Brattain was one of 62 students who made decisions to follow Christ in 2021. Twenty-five of those were baptized last year, 22 are awaiting baptism and the remaining 15 are being disciplined about baptism.

Most of the decisions took place during summer camp

and a “Disciple Now” weekend, but the student ministry also reaped spiritual fruit at a Wednesday night event in October that featured former American Ninja Warrior contestant Jared Greer. Despite an unexpected storm and a loss of power, the Holy Spirit moved 21

LBFCU's Allbritton to retire Feb. 14

ALEXANDRIA, La. (LBM) – Paul Allbritton wanted to use his financial knowledge as a ministry when he became manager of the Baptist Employees of Louisiana Credit Union in 2010.

Allbritton, who will retire, Feb. 14, from what is now the Louisiana Baptist Federal Credit Union, is grateful for the opportunity God has given him to help hundreds of members obtain car loans, refinance high

interest rate credit card loans and receive financial advice based on biblical precepts.

"My time here has been very rewarding," Allbritton told the *Baptist Message*. "I've loved working with people over these years and have enjoyed helping members who sometimes may not have been able to get help in other places."

Allbritton, a native of Shreveport, previously worked at three other credit unions: Alexandria USDA Credit Union, Pineville (vice president

of lending, 1988-2006); Willis-Knighton Federal Credit Union, Shreveport (president/CEO, 2007-2009); and Heart of Louisiana Federal Credit Union, Pineville (formerly Alexandria USDA FCU; collections manager, 2009-2010).

When he assumed his BELCU role in 2010, membership was restricted to employees of the Louisiana Baptist Convention and its entities. Realizing the need to grow, Allbritton and his board of trustees worked to open membership in 2013 to any Louisiana Baptist whose church is a cooperative partner with the Louisiana Baptist Convention. A year later, the ministry was renamed the Louisiana Baptist Federal Credit Union.

Other notable accomplishments during his leadership include updating the computer system

(providing a cost-savings benefit) and increasing the credit union's loan portfolio from \$2.8 million to \$4 million.

"The changes have allowed the credit union to reduce expenses and be more competitive," Allbritton said. "I feel we have a great foundation for the next manager to build upon."

Looking toward retirement, Allbritton hopes to spend more time working on home improvement and vehicle restoration projects. He also plans to volunteer in

the community, golf, fish and continue to worship with First Baptist Church, Pineville; and he will help as asked by his wife and daughter with their women's clothing business.

"I have been blessed to have the support of a wonderful wife and family," Allbritton said. "I have also had a great group of directors on the credit union board. They have allowed me a lot of latitude to manage the credit union, and were always there if I needed them."

of the 170 students in the crowd to accept Christ.

"God worked in such an incredible way," Yates said. "We had been praying for a harvest for so long. It was a joy to see God at work."

Yates said the spiritual renewal was reflected in the students' newfound passion for reaching friends for Christ at school.

"Some of our kids got saved and then the excitement blew up to

where they were sharing Christ with their friends and seeing them accept Christ," Yates said. "It's my prayer that kids get saved and they reach their family with the testimony of their changed lives."

The movement among the students comes as Maplewood First Baptist Church continues to overcome the multiple calamities of the coronavirus pandemic and two hurricanes.

Hurricanes Laura and Delta leveled a two-story building that also hosted Sunday school classrooms and a Christian school. The back wall of the worship center also was destroyed, but the congregation has continued to meet in the facility while the repairs are being made.

The weekday school and Sunday school classes are meeting in other buildings on campus, and construction on a new facility is expected to begin in the spring.

Pastor Jeremy Blocker said he is grateful for his congregation's unwavering faith through disaster after disaster, and for God's supernatural ways. "One cool thing is

we can trace this movement in the youth group to a couple of youth inviting their friends to a Wednesday night gathering in our student ministry," Blocker said. "Their friends got saved and invited other friends. Many of them got saved

and the cycle has continued to this day.

"What Laura and Delta took away, we are viewing as a gift," Blocker continued, "because we have been able to plan for the future instead of rebuilding for the past."

conditioning system and restrooms. Leaders are anticipating an April dedication of the facility.

"Our volunteers and churches have committed to seeing this rebuild ministry through to completion for the glory of God," Statham told the *Baptist Message*.

St. Matthew Baptist is one of nine Baptist churches (there are a total of 13 Baptist churches on the island) severely damaged or destroyed by the storm that packed 185-mile per hour winds at the height of Hurricane Dorian on Sept. 2, 2019.

Louisiana is among several states participating in 'Bahama Rebuild,' a partnership with the International Mission Board and Baptist Global Response. Louisiana and Mississippi have sent numerous teams to rebuild the church while the Baptist state conventions of Alabama and North Carolina are sending additional teams to undertake other projects on the islands.

Since the first team arrived in late December 2019, teams have completed the foundation, driveway, walls, ceiling, floors and electrical lines.

But the project also encountered some difficulties:

-- In July 2020, the Bahamian government closed the borders to most U.S. travelers because of

COVID, and for the next 12 months Louisiana Baptist Disaster Relief teams were unable to work in the country.

-- Additionally, costs of building materials have risen.

Now Louisiana Baptists are nearing the finish line for the project.

"Louisiana Baptists have done a great thing for this community because they could have never accomplished this on their own," Louisi-

ana Baptist Mission and Ministry Director John Hebert said. "This community is remote, and it would have taken a decade or more for these people -- with no homes to live in themselves -- to reestablish the ministry at St. Matthews. What we've done is given these people in Pelican Point a jump on their ministry by a decade so they can continue to offer their community a hope for the future."

Ouachita Baptist celebrates debt retirement

WEST MONROE, La. (LBM) – Ouachita Baptist Church recently celebrated the retirement of \$735,000 in debt on their worship center and fellowship hall.

Members rejoiced during a special note-burning service, Jan. 9, especially noting God's faithfulness to them during the six-year journey.

"I'm just so proud of my church and what God did through them," Pastor Mike Holloway told the *Baptist Message*. "The financial burden is lifted, and the future is bright. We are not the church we were five years ago, but we aren't the church we are going to be five years from now."

When Holloway arrived as pastor in January 2016, the church was struggling to pay the monthly note. A year later, Holloway

presented "2020 Vision," a plan to retire the remaining debt of \$500,000 within four years. COVID caused a one-year delay in reaching the goal, but the note was paid in full, Jan. 9.

Ray Anding, a member of the church since its founding 37 years ago, was honored to be one of the two members who paid off the remaining \$30,000 prior to the note-burning service.

"Everybody was clapping; we were on cloud nine," Anding said. "We remembered how God has blessed our church. Prayer and reaching out to others have been so important during the last few years as we worked together to pay off this loan."

Holloway said the bold step of faith by the congregation has produced much fruit.

When they began the ambitious plan, 50-60 at-

tended Sunday worship and missions giving was down. By the end of 2021, attendance had grown to nearly 200 and giving to efforts to further the Gospel similarly increased.

Holloway said members have become more enthusiastic about sharing the Gospel through prayer, door-to-door evangelism, tent revivals and a ministry to people addicted to drugs, alcohol and other destructive lifestyles.

He said they now regularly participate in mission efforts in the Ukraine, the Navajo reservation in New Mexico, Malawi and Zambia. Holloway said retirement of the debt has freed up the congregation to purchase a \$9,000 church facility for a Zambian congregation, and he expects even more opportunities to give.

"Our church is built on prayer, outreach, evangelism, conservative preach-

ing and genuine worship," Holloway said. "Evangelism still works. The word of God won't return void. How will they believe without a preacher, or unless someone goes and

tells them? We practice the Great Commission here and paying off this debt has now freed us to do even more in missions to share the Good News around the world."

Despite sizable needs, Celebration Church continues to serve

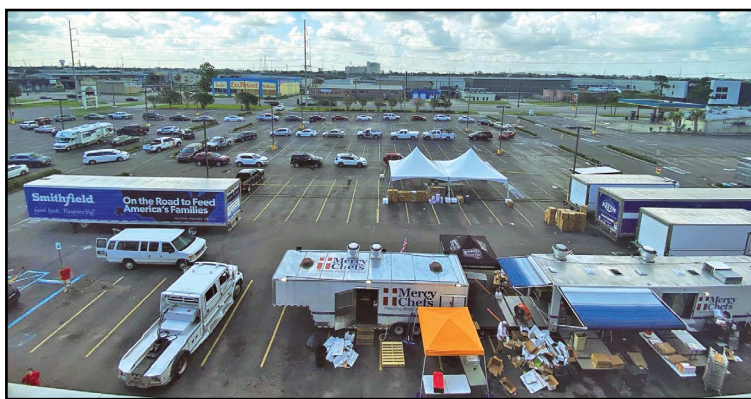
METAIRIE, La. (LBM) —Hurricane Ida wreaked significant damage to five of Celebration Church's eight campus facilities and hundreds of members' homes, Aug. 29, 2021. But instead of pausing, the congregation has pressed forward in ministry, despite substantial repair needs.

"Serving our community has been a part of our DNA for a long time," Celebration Church Lead Pastor Dennis Watson told the *Baptist Message*. "For most of our history we have talked about how we exist to bring honor and glory to God and to help people in the communities around us. We tell people when they join our church, we expect them to serve in the church or community, or both. Our people, in the midst of their own personal challenges and tragedies, continue to reach out to help others."

COVID STRUGGLES

Like other Louisiana Baptist congregations, Celebration Church was not immune from the impacts of COVID.

In January 2020, Celebration Church averaged 7,000 in combined worship attendance at its eight campuses in the New Orleans area and

Northshore. But two months later, COVID-related safety concerns caused the church to move to online-only worship.

When in-person services resumed, June 2020, members slowly returned, with 3,800 attending about a year later, the most since the onset of the pandemic. A month after the high attendance Sunday, 102 new converts were baptized as part of a special "All In" weekend across its campuses. A week later crowds dropped again due to the

emergence of the COVID-19 Delta variant.

IDA IMPACTS

When Ida made landfall, the congregation's challenges deepened:

- a wall was destroyed and the roof damaged at the Lower St. Bernard Parish facility, Violet;
- much of the building was destroyed on the Westbank campus, Marrero (members are meeting at Life Center Cathedral Church, Marrero, five miles away);
- the worship cen-

ter sustained significant damage in Metairie-New Orleans (but members continue to meet there);

-- in Kenner, the worship center roof and outside walls collapsed (the congregation meets in a smaller onsite facility where the Kenner Hispanic congregation previously met);

-- and members attending the River Parishes campus, LaPlace, were displaced because of damage to the building, and now meet at First Assembly of God, LaPlace (one mile down the road).

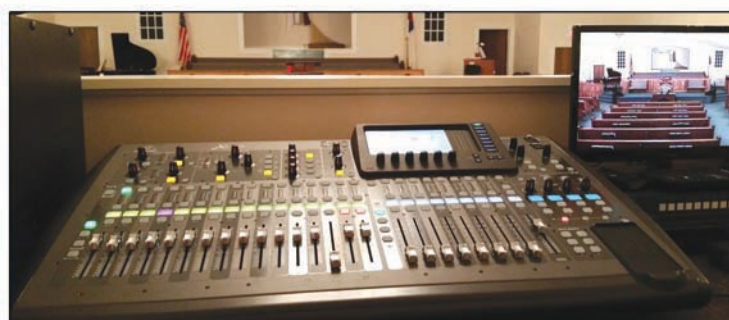
Watson said the work on the Kenner, River Parishes and Westbank campuses may not be complete until late 2023. Repairs to the facilities on the Lower St. Bernard and Metairie-New Orleans campuses should be done later this year.

Watson's home also was damaged. However, he and his wife, Vicki, were able to move back into it, mid-January, after living in temporary lodging since Ida.

MOVING FORWARD

Despite all the setbacks, members served the people in their region multiple ways after Ida, Watson said:

- partnered with Mercy Chefs, a faith-based group, to serve more than 225,000 meals in September;
- distributed relief supplies, donated by others, to thousands of families impacted by Ida;
- removed downed trees, tarped roofs for senior adults and single moms; and
- performed mud out services in flooded houses.

Looking to the new year, he said the congregation will focus on four key initiatives: continue to repair campus facilities, engage the commu-

nity, make more disciples, and equip parents to disciple their children.

"We want our people to be followers of Jesus and not just Jesus fans," Watson said. "We expect to bounce back from all this craziness."

"I posted on my Facebook page, recently, a photo of a church sign that said, 'Living without God is like trying to dribble a football,'" he shared. "There are so many stress factors that people are dealing with; and if they don't have the Lord and a church family in these times, they will struggle mentally, emotionally, relationally, financially and spiritually."

"To stay connected to the Lord, people need to be part of a church family," he continued,

officials claim women are being given gender equality to work in factories, etc.)

-- imprisonment (1-3 million men, women and children are being held in concentration camps that China claims are voluntary re-education and vocational training centers)

Yet, despite these known criminal offenses, China is set to host the 2022 Winter Olympics, starting Feb. 4.

Why do the Uyghur people matter to China?

They compose about half the population of the Xinjiang Province, about 12 million of the 25 million people living there (but less than one percent of China's population), and they have a distinct Turkic culture which is decidedly different from the Han majority culture of the rest of the country.

Communist leaders view the religious and ethnic differences as divisive, disruptive and thus threatening to China's political and economic stability, especially because Xinjiang is a strategic region, producing 84 percent of China's cotton and holding the largest reserves of coal, oil and natural gas in the country. Moreover, it's location is key to China's expansion of the "New Silk Road" of commerce to Europe, complementing its "String of Pearls" military expansion of ports

along the Indian Ocean, giving it protected sea lines to Africa.

Why should the Uyghur people matter to you and me?

Some might argue that if we do not help the Uyghurs, Christians are next. But there already is religious persecution of Christians in China, and international monitors of such activity say it is worsening.

Rather, Christians should be appalled and angered to do something to help the Uyghurs because it's the right thing to do regardless of whether the Uyghurs are "one of us" or not. We should care about the Uyghurs because of "The Good Samaritan."

In that parable, Jesus shared how a priest and a Levite avoided even coming near the naked body of a victim left by robbers on the road from Jerusalem to Jericho. The priest was specifically prohibited from touching a dead body (Lev. 21:1), so investigating for life signs had some risk for him. But everyone else in Israel would have been declared unclean for touching a dead body, as well (Nu. 19:11-13), so the Levite passed on the other side of the road, too.

However, a Samaritan, a person who, because of his mixed ethnicity, was avoided by devout Jews, stopped to care for the stranger, who is not identified as either Jew or Gentile. Regardless, the Samaritan followed the law of compassion that both religious leaders ignored: "Show

mercy and compassion everyone to his brother" (Zechariah 7:9).

Jesus then emphasized that a "brother" or a "neighbor" is more than just "someone like me" -- whether by bloodline, nationality or religion. It is anyone and everyone -- all people.

Meanwhile, secular America should be concerned as well.

The American Chamber of Commerce in China lists 338 U.S.-based companies operating there. Additionally, the United States is sending one of the largest contingents to the Beijing Games among the 91 qualifying nations. Yet, the public outcry has been muted about China's crimes against its people -- eerily reminiscent of the backdrop for the Berlin Olympics of 1936.

In 1933, almost immediately after coming to power, Hitler built Dachau, Germany's first concentration camp. But by 1936 there were hundreds of concentration camps and detention centers all over Germany, including the large SS facilities of Oranienburg, Esterwegen, Lichtenburg and Columbia Haus; and tens of thousands of political prisoners were being jailed, and many tortured,

in these facilities. Moreover, using legislation, Hitler had been taking away the rights of Jews (less than one percent of the population), moving toward purifying the German race. Jewish athletes were even barred from Germany's Olympic team.

Some groups proposed boycotting the Olympic Games because of the crimes being committed against the people. But big business had significant investments in Germany, and U.S. companies like Ford and General Motors were focused on protecting their profits in 1936, not fretting about human rights abuses in the country. Indeed, these automotive manufacturers were still operating in Germany under their respective American parent company's control even after the outbreak of war in 1939, according to thenation.com and washingtonpost.com.

Meanwhile, sports groups, including a majority membership of the Amateur Athletic Union as reported by newspapers of that day, argued that the best thing would be to participate and beat Hitler's athletes.

However, when the Berlin Games ended, Hitler's Germany had amassed the most

medals of any country, with the United States coming in a distant second in total medals as well as in each of the gold, silver and bronze counts.

On top of that, just three years later, our GIs were shocked to battle Nazis who were driving Ford-built trucks and flying Opel-built warplanes (a GM subsidiary).

Now, our political elites are debating whether the offenses by China are "crimes against humanity," or "ethnic cleansing," or "genocide" (as narrowly defined by the Genocide Convention of 1948). In the meantime, 12 million people are being terrorized for simply being different.

Jesus told a lawyer the most important law was to love God completely and the second was to love your neighbor as much as you love yourself (Matthew 22:36-40). Later, He gave a new standard, calling on His followers to love their neighbors "as I have loved you" (John 13:34-35).

Jesus loved us to the point of giving His life that we might live.

America's Christians need to consider what we are willing to sacrifice to show the Uyghurs we do indeed care.

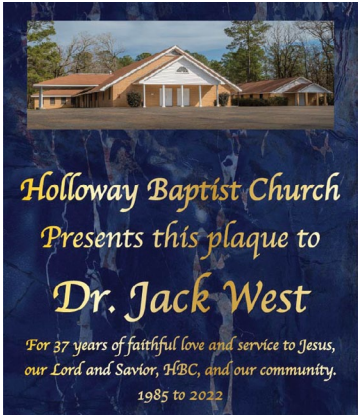

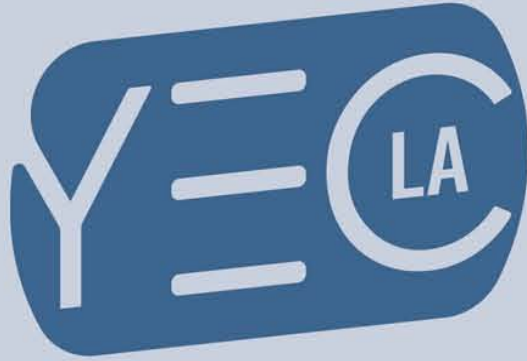
