## Wheelchair is no obstacle to believer's baptism

GLENMORA, La. (LBM) – Being wheelchair-bound could not stop 68-year-old Jack Butler from publicly declaring his faith in Jesus through baptism, May 15.

Six men, three on each side, carried Butler on a wooden plank and then placed him in the water while Pastor Neil Treme baptized him at Glenmora Baptist Church. Moments later, Brandy Butler, 45, followed.

“Whatever it took, Jack wanted to profess his faith in Christ,”

Treme told the *Message*. “Jack really wanted people to know that he was following Christ, even though he was very sick.”

The couple accepted Christ, April 22, during an in-home visit from long-time friend James Irvine and Treme. Irvin led Jack and Treme led Brandy to a relationship with Jesus during the encounter.

“After 45 minutes, I asked them if they happened to be right with the Lord and they said no,” Irvine recalled. “I told them we can take care of that right now and I shared Scripture

with them.

“It was an awesome experience to be able to lead someone like that to the Lord and then see the husband want to be baptized no matter what it took,” he continued. “God reminded me that you should never give up on people. If God wants to do something, he will make a way to see it through no matter how impossible it may seem.”

Since September 2020, nine new converts have been baptized at Glenmora Baptist, which aver-

## NOLA church plant is growing the Kingdom

NEW ORLEANS (LBM) – More than 100 volunteers from eight churches

have spent a portion of the summer helping Immanuel Community Church expand its Gospel reach into the community through the construction of a mul-

tipurpose facility in New Orleans.

Under the direction of Louisiana Baptist Mission Builders Field Strategist Mark Jelks, teams from Wisconsin, Alabama, Mississippi and Kentucky are working with Louisiana Baptists to construct the 10,000-square-foot facility. When completed, the facility will house a worship center (with seating for up to 400), children's area, fellowship hall and offices.

Groundbreaking on the property was held in June and the new facility is expected to open by November on property that once was home to Elysian Fields Baptist Church, which closed after Hurricane Katrina severely damage the campus in 2005.

## LBCH prepares to meet more adoption, foster care needs

MONROE, La. (LBM)—Louisiana Baptist Children's Home and Family Ministries is preparing for an expected increase in needs for adoption and foster care following the Supreme Court ruling in *Dobbs v. Jackson* which permitted Louisiana to enact a ban on abortions.

“We know that more babies will be placed in state foster care and more babies will need adoptive, forever families,” said Perry Hancock, LBCHFM president and CEO. “We want to be ready to meet those needs.”

Hancock described how the ministry's Connect-1Child program (connect-1child.org) assists foster and adoptive families and helps Louisiana Baptist churches and associations to develop ministries that support the foster care/

# Retired Townsend reflects on 28 years of impacting young lives

JENA, La. (LBM) – Terry Townsend has served churches in Texas and

Louisiana for 35 years, committing the last 28 years as student minister with First Baptist Church, Jena, before retiring July 17.  
“It’s been a privilege

and an honor to minister to people, and to spread the Gospel,” Townsend told the Baptist Message. “God has put a lot of great people in my life that have not only helped me grow as a Christian but also helped me in ministry. I appreciate those who have invested in me and helped me in this journey.”

A native of Columbus, Ohio, Townsend’s spiritual journey began in 1969, when he sought permission to date a young lady. Her father, who was the pas-

tor with Southside Baptist Church in Columbus, said Townsend must first attend church with the family. For the next month, Townsend soaked in biblical truths at worship services and during the car ride back to his home.

“Through his ministry, I realized I was a sinner in need of a Savior,” Townsend said. “In the middle of one of his sermons, the Holy Spirit rocked my world and I asked Jesus into my heart. The girl soon dropped me, but I got the better end of the deal.”

Immediately after he accepted Christ, Townsend shared the Truth with his friends, discovering that most of them attended church but had not bothered to tell him about Jesus.

“I thought that was odd,” he recalled. “Why wouldn’t you want to share the Good News with everybody?”

Townsend continued to grow in his faith as a high school junior, when his family moved to Huber Heights, Ohio. He attended Fellowship of Christian Athlete meetings at Wayne High School and became friends with the director,

Ken Rebok, who discipled and encouraged him to pursue Christ on a deeper level.

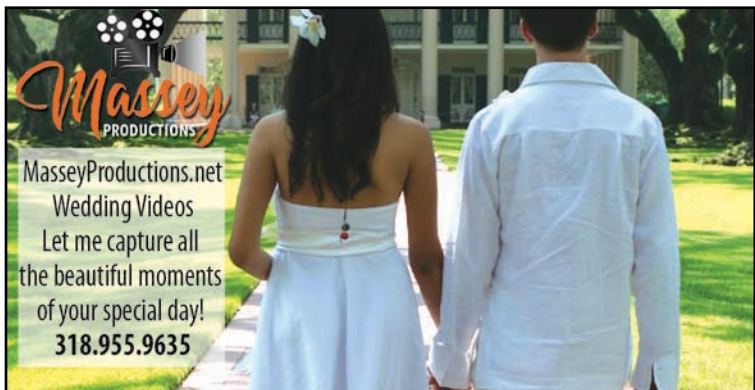
“Ken Rebok taught me about the importance of reading God’s Word on a daily basis and how to share practical spiritual truths with other teenagers,” he said.

After his high school graduation, Townsend joined the United States Air Force, serving eight years before he was honorably discharged in 1982. He then enrolled at Louisiana College (now Louisiana Christian University) to begin training for youth ministry.

He graduated from LC and then Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Fort Worth, Texas. Then he served on church staffs with First Baptist Church, Columbus, Texas; Trinity Baptist Church, Pineville, Louisiana; Donahue Family Church (now Journey Church), Pineville; and First Baptist Church, Jena.

While serving with FBC Jena, he introduced more than 2,000 children and their families to the Gospel through 18 seasons of Upward Basketball, took students to 27 summer camps,

Delaughter told the *Baptist Message*. "We want to see those youth not go the route of so many in New Orleans who have chosen violence. Instead, we hope to help them know the joy of Jesus and a life of generosity. We want Immanuel to be that faithful witness to Jesus and hope through the years we will have a significance influence in our community."

ICC started in the Tremé neighborhood of New Orleans as a church plant of Immanuel Baptist Church, Louisville, Kentucky, in 2015. The church worshipped there until relocating in 2020 to Gentilly Baptist Church, which is fewer than 2 miles from where the new facility is under construction. Delaughter asked for prayers as his church tries to finish the project by November.

## OPEN DOORS

Construction of the multipurpose building has opened

doors to sharing the Gospel in the neighborhood, Delaughter said.

The church has prayer walked, given appreciation gifts to teachers at the nearby Bethune Elementary School and served 500 meals a day for two weeks after Hurricane Ida made landfall in 2021. Additionally, North American Mission Board "Gen Send" summer missionaries have canvassed the neighborhood to gather demographics and share Christ with homeowners.

Residents have been grateful for the bold witness of the congregation and other mission teams, who have continued with construction efforts despite multiple thefts of tools, building materials and other items (totaling more than \$15,000). **[Contact iccnola@gmail.com to help replace stolen items]**

"One lady gives pop-sicles to the volunteers just about every day and others have brought over water

to them," Delaughter said. "They want us to be here, and they can't wait for us to open in a few months."

## GOSPEL MISSION

Louisiana Baptist Missions and Ministry Team Director John Hebert commended Delaughter and his congregation for remaining steadfast in their Gospel-centered mission.

"Matthew Delaughter has been building his congregation and reaching people since the very beginning the church was planted," Hebert said. "I'll never forget how impressed I was with him the first time we met. Our initial meeting about the construction of this facility was about three years ago, before COVID. With the Lord's help the project is finally coming to fruition."

Jelks, the son of Mission Builders founder Ed Jelks, said ICC is the latest construction project undertaken by Mission Builders this year.

Three crews along with

church members are rebuilding the 10,000-square-foot worship center at Marlow Baptist that was destroyed by a tornado in 2019; and more than 80 volunteers are building a 4,000-square-foot multipurpose facility for the Way Church, Leesville. Teams also are renovating a 27,000-sq.-ft. multi-purpose facility at Pine Ridge Baptist Church, Melder.

Louisiana Baptist Di-

saster Relief Associate and Volunteer Mobilizer Mark Morelock said the ICC project is a reminder of how the church can bring hope to a community.

"He gets the glory," Morelock said. "Even in tough times, hope continues."

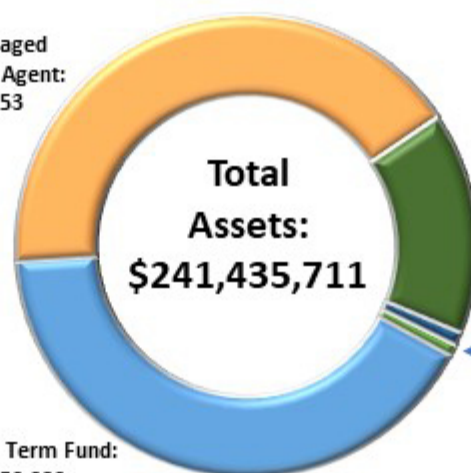

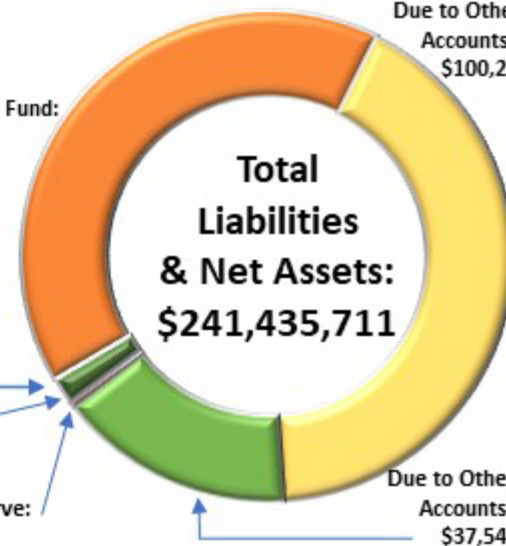

## Groundbreaking shows God's faithfulness at Riverview

ALEXANDRIA, La. (LBM) – Riverview Baptist Church held a groundbreaking ceremony, July 17, to celebrate the beginning of construction on a new multi-purpose facility that will serve future genera-

tions.

Pastor David Newton told the *Baptist Message* the new facility will ensure the church has adequate space to meet the needs of a growing congregation.

Since February 2020 (just prior to Louisiana Gov. John Bel Edwards's COVID-related worship

attendance restrictions), Sunday worship attendance has increased from 92 to as high as 115 in February 2022.

Moreover, the church has baptized seven new believers who committed their lives to Jesus during

a revival in early January. Additionally, Newton, on July 24, will baptize a youngster who, during Vacation Bible School in June, chose to follow Jesus.

"I have a great supportive group of deacons and others in our church who do great things," he said. "Our music minister Brother Mike Boone, for instance, has been our point man in this project and he has tirelessly got this project to where we are today.

"We are seeing God move and things happen because of the leadership here," he continued. "We have church members from all walks of life that are investing in, inviting and discipling others. Our hope is God will continue to use this not just as a members-only Riverview Baptist building but as a community building, so

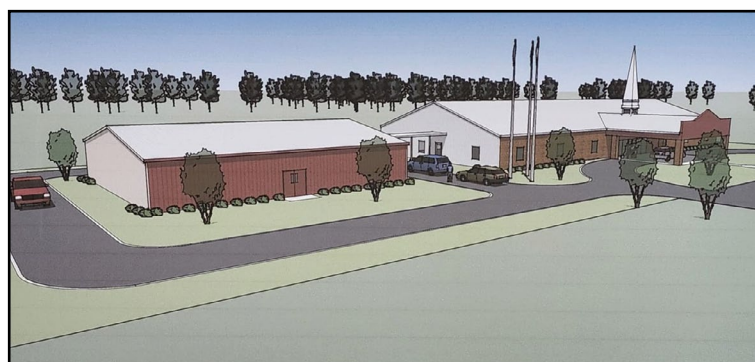
we can minister and be a lighthouse through everything God is doing."

Once complete, the 4,875-square-foot facility will include space to accommodate 250 people -- for conferences and small groups. The project is scheduled for completion in December.

Newton asked for prayers for safety and timeliness of the construction and for the congregation's efforts to spread the Gospel in Central Louisiana.

"While we are called

to be Kingdom-focused and not to treasure the things of this world, because one day they will be consumed by fire, we are called to use the resources and blessings that we have to reach out and minister for the glory of God," he said. "In Mark 10:46-52 we read the story of blind Bartimaeus. Jesus was on the way to Jerusalem for the last time, and as He reached Jericho, Bartimaeus called out to Jesus and was healed. If Bartimaeus would have waited until Jesus was returning, he would have missed out and never been healed. Our prayer is that no one who walks in this build-

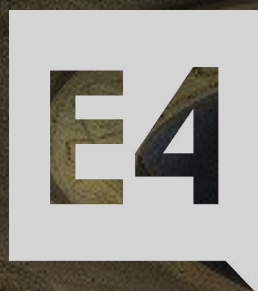

# Smith honored for 45 years as Lakeshore Baptist pastor

MONROE, La. (LBM) – William Smith has led Lakeshore Baptist Church as pastor for nearly half a century.

For his 45 years of service to the Monroe congregation and community, Smith was honored during a service July 10 that included two baptisms, memories shared by friends and family, a song composed in his honor, a monetary gift from the congregation and a word of appreciation from Loui-

siana Baptist Executive Director Steve Horn.

“It is a calling,” Smith told the *Baptist Message*. “When you know God has called you, it is who you are. We have had opportunities to go other places, but I have known this is where God wants me.”

Raised in Crowville, Smith surrendered his heart and life to Christ, at age 10, while attending First Baptist Church, Crowville, and responded to the call to ministry while attending a missions emphasis week at the former Ridgcrest Baptist

Conference Center, Black Mountain, N.C., when he was 18 years old.

“I spent a lot of time in the prayer garden and asked God what was I supposed to do,” Smith said. “During one of the services at camp, the song ‘I Surrender All’ was played and it was then that I told God I was surrendering my future plans to him.”

The Lord reaffirmed his call to ministry during his freshman year at Louisiana College (now Louisiana Christian University). Since that time, he has served as music minister, Lee Heights Baptist Church, Tioga; music and youth director, First Baptist Church, Georgetown; pastor, Zion Baptist Church, Georgetown; and finally, as pastor, Lakeshore Baptist.

Smith also has served Louisiana Baptists as a member/trustee with the: LBC Executive Board (1977, 1989-95 and 2019-pres-

ent); Louisiana Baptist Children’s Home and Family Ministries (2010-2016); Louisiana Christian University (1982-88 and 1999-2005); and Northeast Louisiana Baptist Association. He also is a board member for Family Promise of Ouachita, a non-profit organization that helps homeless and low-income families achieve sustainable independence through

## Philadelphia Baptist celebrates 150 years of Gospel impact

DEVILLE, La. (LBM) —Philadelphia Baptist Church celebrated 150 years of ministry in Central Louisiana with a special service, June 26, which commemorated its beginning in 1872.

The celebration, attended by 600 members and guests, included Sunday worship messages from Pastor Philip Robertson and three former pastors (Stacy Morgan, Terry Faulkenbury and Huey Tarpley) followed by a meal.

There were activities such as a photo booth, inflatables and games; and there was a historical walk of faith display of photos and artifacts with special significance to the founding of the congregation and its ministry impact throughout the years.

The day concluded with an evening fireworks extravaganza and fellowship.

Pastor Philip Robertson told the *Baptist Message* that throughout its history, a common theme for Philadelphia Baptist has been God's faithfulness.

"I've often tried to imagine what it must have been like in 1872

when a small group of pioneer Christians in the piney woods of Central Louisiana met for the very first time, sensing God's call to start a church. Most likely inspired by Jesus' letter to the church at Philadelphia in Revelation 3:7-13, they called the new church Philadelphia Baptist Church. Could they even have imagined that the Gospel seeds of

faith they were sowing would still be producing a harvest a century and a half later.

"So, here we are today, with the same mission, the same omnipotent God as the head of His church, and His same sufficient Word to lead us. Now, the torch of faith is in our hands and may God help us to continue to run the race till Jesus returns."

store for the congregation.

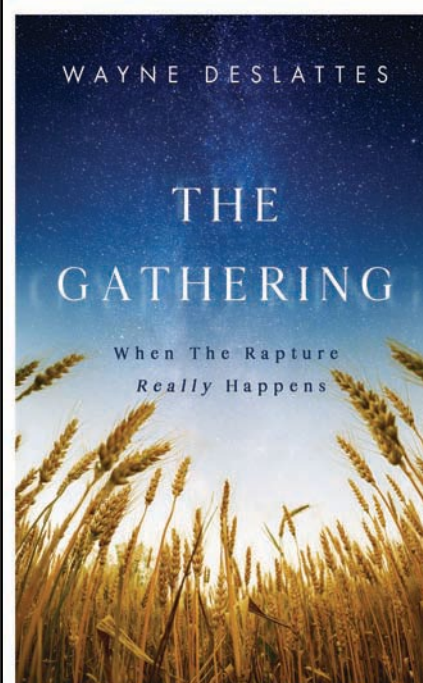

# LBC seeks resolutions, nominees for committees, boards

and witnessed hundreds of students grow in faith at the annual Louisiana Baptist Youth Evangelism Celebrations.

adoption community (e.g., support groups, respite care services, life essential ministries, etc.).

"We provide an introduction and orientation for families sensing God's call to foster or adopt," Hancock explained. "Our adoption specialists also provide training and certification services for those Louisiana Baptist families. In addition, the Children's Home provides ongoing and in-home support."

Also, he said, the Children's Home assists mothers with the adoption process and provides referrals to local agencies for services that it does not offer. Meanwhile, through its HomePlace ministry it offers temporary

housing to mothers and their babies after delivery.

"The Children's Home already has the staff, program, and means to meet the coming need," Hancock offered. "We simply must have more families answer God's call to serve."

"We know that times of great challenge are also times of great opportunity," he continued. "We have a great opportunity to make a significant, kingdom difference in the days ahead. I would ask that all Louisiana Baptists pray and consider what role they might play to help meet these needs and change lives in Jesus' name."

ages 115 for Sunday worship.

Treme said the baptisms reflect the congregation's passion for seeing others come to Christ. Despite COVID-19, the church has seen growth in its ministry to young adults, ages 19-40 (from 12 in February 2020 to 35 in early May 2022). The church also has seen the community respond to such outreach efforts as

weekly visitation, meals for teachers in Glenmora and Vacation Bible School.

"God taught us whatever it takes to lead people to the Lord we have to be willing to do it," Treme said. "It doesn't matter if we have to go to the creek or pool to help someone be obedient and follow through with baptism. There are no barriers to what God can do."

# Sen. Kennedy offers encouragement, insights to Louisiana Baptists

ALEXANDRIA, La. (LBM)—U.S. Senator John Kennedy stopped by the Louisiana Baptist state mission center in Alexan-

dria, July 7, to share words of encouragement and gratitude about statewide disaster relief efforts during the last two years, and he weighed in on some key social issues impacting the state and the nation.

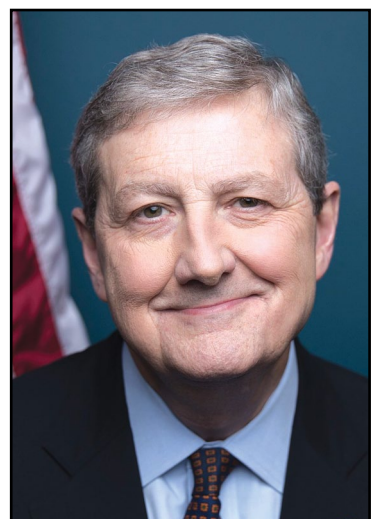
In a meeting with Steve Horn, executive director of the Louisiana Baptist Convention, Kennedy lauded the faith community for its quick and sustained response to the four hurricanes which devastated the state, 2020-2021.

"Every place I went it was the churches, they were there. I'm not putting down first responders, but it was the churches who provided the infrastructure," he offered. "They are the ones who did most of the work."

Kennedy said Louisianans now are having to deal with insurers who do not want the risk of writing policies in areas hit hard by Hurricanes Laura, Delta, Zeta and Ida.

"I hear complaints every day," he said.

"President Biden implemented a new program based on a computer algo-

rithm they say can measure risk over the next 100 years of every individual home," he said. "When we asked to see the computer software -- to let our people look at it -- they wouldn't. It's going to hit Louisiana hard. There are about 5 million policyholders in the country, with 500,000 of them in Louisiana."

A member of the powerful Senate Appropriations Committee, Kennedy also shared his concerns about inflation's impact on the nation and the double hit on Louisiana because of the Biden Administration's attacks on the energy sector. He said he worked hard to make sure Louisiana got its fair share of fed-

eral money, but that some funding was excessive.

"Congress appropriated outside its normal budget about \$7 trillion. Probably the first \$4 trillion was necessary," he said. "But then President Biden -- when the economy was recovering, we were in a V-shaped recovery -- insisted on passing another coronavirus bill which wasn't a coronavirus bill. It was a Green New Deal and welfare bill. That put us over the top."

He said the infusion of this extra cash kick started inflation "almost immediately."

Now, he said, the Federal Reserve must "soak up" the \$7 trillion it printed; Congress must "stick with its budget"; and the president "has to get his boot off the neck off the oil and gas industry" -- adding emphasis to this third point.

"Three years ago, we were energy independent and nothing Russia did, or the Middle East did was of consequence to us -- we were producing our own fuel. President Biden has forfeited our energy independence," he added. "There is a shortage of oil and natural gas, therefore

the price went up on us.”

He emphasized that more cheap fossil fuel is needed to pull the country and the world out of the present financial crisis, arguing that the economy “cannot grow without energy.”

“The truth is there is great potential in wind and solar and hydroelectric power,” Kennedy observed, adding that there needs to be a new emphasis on nuclear power, too. But, he insisted, “Fossil fuels have got to be a part of the plan. Eighty percent of our energy comes from fossil fuels. You can’t just get up on a Monday morning and say, ‘No more fossil fuels.’”

Sen. Kennedy took time to address key social issues as well.

Regarding the recent surge of chemical and surgical procedures to effect transgender transitions among teens and adolescents, Kennedy said the “science is pretty clear.”

“There are two genders: male and female,” he said. “Gender dysphoria does exist, but it’s extremely rare. If you want to talk about a lifestyle change and dress another way that’s one thing. But once it becomes a medical issue that’s quite another thing.”

On this point, he said the United States is behind countries in Europe and Scandinavia (some that pioneered transgender procedures), which have taken steps to protect children and youth from permanent changes to their young bodies by making them wait until they are young adults and mature enough to give informed consent.

“One of the drugs they give these young people is the same drug that pedophiles voluntarily take. It’s chemical castration and medically irreversible,” he added. “It’s insanity.”

Kennedy also expressed alarm about “the deterioration of the family and the nation,”

pointing to a radio report he heard earlier in the day about the crime spree erupting in New Orleans and noting that the key issue was not being addressed.

“There is a reason society, for thousands of years, has organized itself around the family unit. If you are raised by a single parent – and we have a lot of single parents -- you are six times as likely to have your child grow up in poverty,” he said.

He noted that fatherlessness also correlates to lawlessness.

“We won’t be able to solve the crime problem until we talk about restoring the family,” he concluded.

Kennedy predicted the marijuana industry will continue to be frustrated by the Senate at least regarding bank access. But he offered that most of the legalization fights “will happen at the state level.”

“We have kind of shut them down at the federal level because they can’t really grow without a financial system. Right now, they can’t use banks,” he explained. “There is a bill to try to change that -- I am against it and I don’t

think it has a chance of passing.”

He said officials, unfortunately, are lured by projections of additional revenues.

“The impetus at the state and local level is the taxes. Same for gambling,” Kennedy said. “It’s all about the money.”

## NEED FOR PRAYER

Kennedy and his wife Becky are founding members of North Cross United Methodist Church in Madisonville, and he said his faith is critical to his work in the nation’s capital on behalf of the people of Louisiana.

“Every morning I pray for wisdom, courage, love and strengthening of my faith,” he shared. “I also pray, ‘Don’t let me hate.’ You’re in this environment in Washington where they are all lined up against you -- the

bureaucracy, the media -- the deck is stacked. But you can’t hate.”

Horn ended the meeting by praying for Kennedy.

# Another 62,000 veterans face expulsion due to vaccine mandate

WASHINGTON (LBM)—The U.S. military continues to negatively impact operational readiness with the continuing purge of active-duty members and now 40,000 Guardsmen and 22,000 Reservists who have declined the COVID-19 vaccines – many asking for religious exemption.

The four FDA-approved drugs that are available to service men and women are tainted by use of tissue from an aborted child either in one or more of the development, production and testing phases.

According to military.com, U.S. Army officials announced, July 8, that these 62,000 veterans will be blocked from service for rejecting COVID vaccines. An estimated 20,000 Guardsmen and Reservists combined have asked for

religious exemptions.

Already, about 20,000 active-duty personnel have asked for religious accommodation:

Army (api.army.mil)

-- As of July 7, only 19 of 4,782 religious exemption requests have been approved.

-- Already, 1,300 soldiers have been separated from military service.

Air Force (airforcemag.com)

-- Just 118 religious exemption requests (all to airmen already leaving voluntarily) have been approved out of more than 9,000 that have been submitted.

-- More than 3,000 non-religious exemption requests have been approved.

Marines (seapowermagaine.org)

-- Only 7 religious exemption requests have been approved out of about 3,700 that have been submitted.

-- About 2,700 Marines

have been discharged, so far.

Navy (navy.mil)

-- More than 4,400 sailors have asked for religious exemptions, with 42 having been approved. Meanwhile, more than 1,000 of these seamen have been separated from military service.

As for combat readiness, multiple reports indicate that as much as 13 percent of Guardsmen could be separated.

Importantly, the Air Force reported in 2019, that it was experiencing a severe shortage of fighter pilots, nearly 2,000, out of a needed 18,400. There are an estimated 700 pilots facing ends to their careers because they have requested religious exemptions to the military's vaccine mandate.

So far, neither the military nor the Biden administration have sought to im-

port any of the 100 percent pro-life ethical vaccines that are available in other countries. For instance, Covaxin (developed in India) is being used in Mexico and Canada. Also, Israel, Germany, South Korea and Japan, all U.S. allies, have developed COVID-19 vaccines that are not tainted with stem cells from unborn children.

## STUDY: Under 40? Don't drink!

SEATTLE (LBM) – A study conducted by the Institute for Health Metrics and Evaluation with the University of Washington has published a study in Lancet, a British medical journal, finding that any amount of alcohol is unhealthy for people under 40 years old.

The global study, which looked at 22 health out-

comes, found that even as little as one-tenth of a standard drink (translating into 0.34 ounces of red wine, 13 percent alcohol by volume; or 1.2 ounces of beer, 3.5 percent alcohol by volume) for a male, 16-39 years old, and one-fourth of a standard drink (0.85 ounces of red wine; 3 ounces of beer) for the same aged girl, per day, had negative impacts, including car accidents, suicides and murder.

The research was released just after the National Institutes of Health released its findings that alcohol-related deaths had surged during 2020.

In Louisiana the "under 40" study likely will be alarming to parents and policy makers as the state's high school students lead their peers in the nation in alcohol use (35 percent).

## Monkeypox surges among gay men

WASHINGTON (LBM)—Although qualifying their statements that monkeypox is not a gay disease, the World Health Organization has announced that the current global outbreak is erupting among "men who have sex with men who have had recent sexual contact with a new partner or partners," with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention stating more mildly that the virus "is spreading mostly through close, intimate contact with someone who has monkeypox."

According to CNN, the CDC considers the risk of infection to be low for the population in general, with scientists clarifying that people are not getting sick simply from walking past someone or giving them a hug or lightly brushing a lesion on the skin. Instead, the higher likelihood of infection is in "back rooms, saunas, or sex clubs, or at sex parties where there's anonymous contact with multiple partners."

The outbreak likely originated at two gay sex parties, one in Spain and the other in Belgium, according to nbcnews.com. WHO data shows there have been 9,200 cases in 63 countries as of July 19, including 1,972 cases in the United States.

WHO is considering the possibility of declaring a "global health emergency." Meanwhile, France's National Health Authority recommends preventive vaccinations for special risk groups such as gay men, some trans people and sex workers.


