

LCU's Total Truth Tour to promote biblical worldview

PINEVILLE, La. (LBM) – Louisiana Christian University is going on the “Total Truth Tour” this spring offering information and resources to fortify a biblical worldview with student groups.

Scheduled at four churches, the tour will

feature guest speaker J.D. Hankins, student minister at First Baptist Church, Rayville, and music led by the LCU's Elevate band:

-- Philadelphia Baptist Church, Deville, Jan. 25, 6:15 p.m.

-- First Baptist Church, Lafayette, Feb. 15, 6 p.m.

-- First Baptist Church, West Monroe, March 22, 6 p.m.

-- Summer Grove Baptist Church, Shreveport, April 19, 6 p.m.

Citing a 2021 Barna study that found just 6 percent of evangelicals adhere to a biblical worldview, LCU President Rick Brewer said events like the Total Truth Tour are needed to help buck that trend.

“Unfortunately, even

among evangelicals in our churches, only a small percentage of youth subscribe to a biblical worldview,” Brewer told the Baptist Message. “We are finding more and more high school students who simply don't believe in moral absolute truth. The tour will help make students not just aware of LCU but equip students to grow in

a deeper understanding of biblical truth.”

Hankins said he is excited to share more with students about how to defend their faith.

“We will have a good time,” Hankins said. “Come and be ready to have fun and talk about Jesus.”

Louisiana BCM team leads 101 to Christ in Mexico

PIEDRAS NEGRAS, Mexico (LBM) – A team of 175 students and staff from six Baptist Collegiate Ministries in the state spent part of their Christmas break sharing the Gospel with thousands in Mexico.

By the conclusion of the Dec. 7-14 mission trip in the state of Coahuila near the U.S.-Mexico border, the team witnessed 110 salvation decisions.

Louisiana State University BCM Director Steve Masters said he was overjoyed with the students' attitude of serving others first, no matter the unfamiliar situations they faced.

“The students worked so hard and so selflessly,”

Masters told the *Baptist Message*. “They put in long hours of work but had a lot of fun. They laughed, they prayed, they served, they gave.”

The team included students and staff from LSU, Louisiana Christian University, University of Louisiana at Monroe, University of Louisiana at Lafayette, McNeese State University and Grambling State University. They worked in Piedras Negras, Acuna and Morelos, and slept and ate at a ministry center in Piedras Negras for a cost of \$9 per night, Masters noted.

The students formed into small groups and worked with more than 300 children and teenagers



Tax law offers refunds to churches

WASHINGTON (LBM) – Churches are eligible for the Employee Retention Credit (tax credit), which could amount up to \$26,000 per employee, according to the Internal Revenue Service website.

The ERC is designed to reimburse small businesses, including non-profits “who continued paying employees while shutdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic or had significant declines in gross receipts from March 13, 2020, to December 31, 2021,” www.irs.gov instructs.

An eligible employer

is defined as one whose trade or business during the qualified timeframe (as defined in IRS bulletins) was fully or partially suspended due to government restrictions on commerce, travel or group meetings “(for commercial, social, religious, or other purposes) due to COVID-19” or if the employer “had a significant decline in gross receipts,” per Internal Revenue Bulletin: 2021-11. Other notices modify the timeframe for eligibility and qualify “recovery startup businesses” for the tax credit and provide other details.

The tax credit is part of the 2020 CARES Act which was passed to help

keep businesses and families afloat when the U.S. economy was shut down during the coronavirus pandemic of 2020-21.

Dale Lingenfelter, Louisiana Baptist’s associate executive director and chief financial officer, explained that the ERC is different than the Paycheck Protection Program.

“It is not a loan like the PPP. It is a true tax credit,” he told the Baptist Message.

“You must file amended 941s,” he said, adding that churches will need to be patient as their applications are processed due to backlogs with the IRS.

But Lingenfelter said the refund should be worth the wait, covering each “quarter for which you qualified within all of 2020, and the first three quarters of 2021.”

He added that any wages used to qualify for the PPP loan package could not be used in qualifying for the ERC, but noted that “If you got PPP, you still qualify for the ERC. You just can’t include the timeframe you used to qualify for PPP in requesting the ERC.”

Lingenfelter urged churches to consult with their respective CPAs, cautioning that many companies have popped up recently to “assist” with filing for the tax credit and they often charge a “commission” that is a large percentage of what is refunded.

2023 CEC to focus on 'together' in Christ

PINEVILLE, La. (LBM) – The next generation of young professionals will be challenged to embrace Christ-centered relationships during the upcoming Collegiate Evangelism Conference, "Together," set for Feb. 10-11 at Louisiana Christian University's Guinn Auditorium in Pineville.

"If you ask a student what they want to talk about, chances are it will be relationships," Chad McClurg, University of Louisiana-Monroe Baptist Collegiate Ministry director and conference organizer, told the Baptist Message. "Relationships are a highly discussed thing in Scripture, and we want our students to have the correct perspective as they live out their daily

lives. We hope to answer those questions they may have about different types of relationships during the weekend.

"Our main sessions will focus on our identity in Christ as the primary relationship, as well as dating and marriage from a godly perspective," he continued. "The breakout sessions will dive deeper into relationships in other areas of life that a college student faces now and in the future."

CEC will feature three speakers: Sean Walker, pastor, the Bayou Church, Lafayette; Kathy Nelson, laywoman, Calvary Baptist Church, Ruston; and Todd Strain, pastor, Calvary Baptist Church, Alexandria, and his wife, Megan.

Leading music will be the Jason Lovins Band, a Christian contemporary band from Ashland, Ken-

tucky.

Students also will have a chance to attend breakout sessions that center around the conference theme and learn about missions and ministry opportunities from representatives of the International Mission Board and North American Mission Board.

McClurg said an annual highlight of the conference is an opportunity for students to fellowship with other Louisiana BCM members around the state.

"This is the one time each year where all of us can gather as a BCM family," McClurg said. "The speakers and band are great but a highlight for so many students is reuniting with others they went on mission trips with and went to high school within our state. Being together is

part of our culture in Louisiana and we look forward to the fellowship at CEC."

Registration for CEC

begins Feb. 10, 5 p.m., with a 7 p.m. start for the main session. The conference concludes at 5 p.m., Feb. 11.

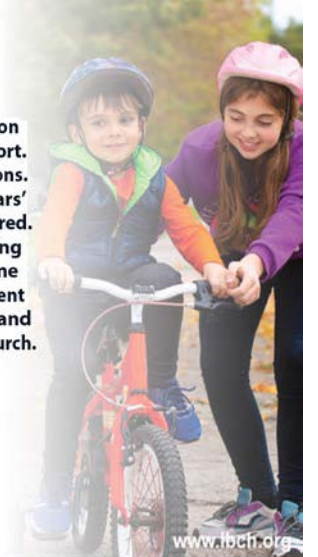

in Bible clubs. They also led worship services at area churches, performed construction projects and helped disciple church members.

LSU BCM member Brenden Williams said the trip reinforced his faith in Christ and forced him to trust Him more.

the week. It was truly a blessing for everyone involved in building God's Kingdom."

McNeese State BCM member Abigail Barrow said the trip fulfilled a childhood dream of helping make disciples in Mexico.

During a service at a youth rally in Acuna, Barrow and her fellow BCM team members joined the Hispanic youngsters in singing "Lord, I Need You."

"Even though we had the divide of languages, we all worshiped and served the same God," she said. "I feel like that night was a taste of what heaven will be like."

LCU BCM member Korey Kincade was given the chance to preach when another team member (who was scheduled to deliver the evening youth rally message) suddenly fell ill. Kincade said he enjoyed preaching to both Louisianians and Hispanic youth and their parents.

"The thing that made it really special was that I was preaching to Chris-

one people that didn't care about race, family status, or poverty levels. We bonded as a fellowship of believers with one common goal, to keep our eyes and hearts on God."

LONG-TERM COMMITMENT

According to Masters, the LSU BCM has been involved with a Mexico mission trip since 1992, with the exceptions of 2010-2015 when travel was prohibitive due to drug cartel violence, and in 2020, when they did not travel to the country because of COVID restrictions.

Masters said that after he spoke with pastors in the country, International Mission Board representatives, border patrol officers and other government officials, he is confident that working in the Piedras Negras

area is safe for mission teams; and he encourages others to consider going there to share Christ's love.

Masters said the mission trip has become an annual tradition for his family.

Though his three daughters are no longer participating because they have moved out of state, Masters said they still have fond memories of time spent in Mexico.

"I started taking my girls on BCM mission trips after they turned seven," he said. "My girls went 10 years as children and teenagers and then four years as college students. It was one of the best things I did for them."

"Happiness not based on material goods but on God and your church," he continued. "There is something about going to a third world country

and serving. You see the true meaning of love and support of church members.

"I invite many more

groups to come and serve in Mexico," he said. "If I can help in any way to set up ministry, I would be glad to do so."

Gospel of Jesus Christ."

At one time, RABC averaged 395 in worship, according to Annual Church Profile of statistics. But through the years attendance steadily decreased, with 35 attending services in 2022.

Rather than move, the members believed God still had a purpose for them at their current location. When Wolfe proposed to his mostly senior adult congregation the idea of transferring the property to NBS, they were enthusiastic about the idea.

"NBS will have plenty of room for growth and RABC will have connection with families for growth," Wolfe said. "But, the greatest blessing for RABC is that our facilities, which are far more than we are able to use and maintain, will be used by

EPHESIANS 5:

Be imitators of the one true God

This is the fifth installment of a six-part series for the January Bible study on the book of Ephesians.

ALEXANDRIA, La. (LBM) – In Chapter 5, Paul emphasized how we should “walk,” calling on the Ephesians to be “imitators of God” and to “walk in love ... light ... wisdom.” Meanwhile, he capped his discussion about righteous living by presenting how husbands and wives were to relate to each other, submitting in their respective ways to reflect the relationship of Christ with His Bride, the Church.

In this final chapter of his letter to the church in Ephesus, Paul gave instructions about the parent-child relationship immediately after addressing the marriage relationship.

Furthermore, he constructed this part of his discussion, “Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for it is right” (v. 1), around the fifth mandate of the Ten Commandments, “Honor your father and mother that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth” (Exodus 20:12).

It is significant that Paul began his discussion about how to walk a new life, by warning the church at Ephesus not to grieve the Spirit (Ephesians 4:30), punctuating this thought by then calling for new believers to be “imitators of God” (Ephesians 5:1) before addressing the relationships in marriage and

family (Ephesians 5:21-33; 6:1-4) -- especially in referencing the Ten Commandments here -- because this same order, God and family, is reflected in the same hierarchy of relationships expressed in the Ten Commandments.

Many may view Exodus 20:3-17 as merely a list of “dos and don’ts.” But it offers much more meaning, and likely guided Paul’s discussion here.

The Ten Commandments provided a primer of sorts to the people of Israel, who, coming out of 400 years of being a people of Pharaoh, needed to learn how to be a people of God – and He shaped His guidance to emphasize relationships!

-- The first four of the commandments address a people’s relationship with God.

-- The fifth lifted up the parent-child relationship, and so the marriage and family relationships.

-- Meanwhile, the prohibitions against murder, adultery, theft, false witness and covetousness guide our relationships with everyone else.

It is not possible to know whether Paul learned this concept while under the tutelage of his mentor Gamaliel, or directly from Christ while

God sustains us relationally

New retirement law presents new charitable planning opportunities

ALEXANDRIA, La. (LBM) -- On December 29, 2022, President Biden signed into law the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023, providing new charitable planning opportunities related to retirement plans.

Under the new law, the annual limit for qualified charitable distributions (QCDs) will be increased annually starting in 2024, indexed for inflation. Currently, individuals 70 1/2 years of age and older can distribute directly from their retirement plans to a charity, such as a church or other ministry, up to \$100,000 annually tax-free.

Additionally, individuals aged 70 1/2 and up can now make an additional one-time \$50,000 QCD for the purpose of creating life income plans, specifically charitable gift annuities and charitable remainder trusts. This opportunity allows individuals to turn a QCD into an income stream for them and leave a gift for ministry after their life.

Lastly, the new law also raises the age for required

minimum distributions (RMDs) from retirement plans to 73 for those born between 1951 and 1959 and to 75 for those born in 1960 or later.

The Total Truth Tour, which also is scheduled for August to November, is the latest effort by LCU to provide students with the

tools to make a difference for Christ in the culture.

For the last six years, LCU has offered several lecture series and conferences to address current spiritual and political issues facing Christ followers. Additionally, messages during the 2022-2023 chapel services are based off the book of Revelation.

Incoming students can apply for the Francis Schaeffer Scholarship Program, renewable annually for four years. To be eligible, students must complete the book “A Student’s Guide to Culture” that centers on how Christians can understand and influence the culture. Applicants then view video lessons taught by LCU professors, complete quizzes and write a final essay about the material.

Once on campus, students are required to attend Baptist Collegiate Ministry services and other cultural events each semester.

Paul was three years in Arabia, or perhaps a combination of both. But his exposition in Ephesians about how to walk – in terms of how it reflects the relationship priorities of the Ten Commandments (God, family, everyone else) – certainly shows consistency with God's first instructions to the people of Israel.

Paul next addressed one of the most difficult relationship conditions of his time in terms of "everyone else" – the relationship between bondservant and master.

It is important to note that it appears Paul was

making a distinction between debt servitude (a means to pay off what is owed another) and chattel slavery (taking someone captive as property), which the Bible condemns (Exodus 21:16; 1 Timothy 1:10). Yet, it is equally true that the fate of a bondservant could be like chattel slavery depending on the temperament of his master.

Regardless, Paul likely addressed this particular relationship from among so many others with "everyone else" because of the high number of bondservants in the Roman Empire.

Historians estimate that up to one-third of the Roman Empire population was comprised of slaves, and another third of freed slaves. Consequently, this relationship was a prevalent one at that time, and Paul addressed it bluntly by saying that you can endure any condition in life if you are first a slave to Christ ("with good will doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men", v. 7).

Likewise, he directed believers who were masters to live differently than before in their relationships with servants ("giving up threatening, knowing that your own Master also is in Heaven, and there is no partiality with Him," v. 9).

Finally, Paul concluded

his instruction about how to walk a new life by providing some spiritual implements to employ for success in combat against "against spiritual hosts of wickedness," (v. 12). Indeed, he used military metaphors ("armor," vv. 11, 13) from what was likely a common sight given the ubiquitous presence of the Roman Army in the Roman Empire:

-- Belt of Truth (v. 14): A soldier used his belt to cinch in all extra uniform fabric to free up their legs and give them more mobility; likewise, the Belt of Truth allows the spiritual warrior to be agile in combat.

-- Breastplate of Righteous (v. 14): The breastplate protected vital organs; Likewise, righteousness protects

the heart of the believer.

-- Shoes of Gospel (v. 15): Roman soldiers wore heavy soled boots that resembled sandals and were hobnailed to give good footing. The Gospel of peace gives believers solid footing when facing life and death situations. Likewise, the Gospel of peace helps believers "stand firm" (v. 6), knowing that the cause for which they fight is to share the Good News with those facing eternity in Hell without it. In close combat, soldiers could even use their shoes as weapons, stomping the hobnails into the feet of the enemy. Similarly, the Gospel of peace can be effective in opposing spiritual attackers.

in the church today. Some feel safe to drink alcohol, arguing that consumption is not condemned, only drunkenness (v. 18). Others read such warnings as "wine is a mocker" (Proverbs 20:1) and conclude all alcohol is a sin. Then there are prescriptions such as give strong drink to "the perishing" and wine to "the bitter" (Proverbs 36:1), and Paul's recommendation to Timothy "use a little wine" for a stomach condition and his "frequent infirmities" (1 Timothy 5:23).

Whatever position the Christian takes on this issue, it is critical that those who approve of drinking carefully consider that drunkards are among those who will not inherit the Kingdom of God (1 Corinthians 6:10). Meanwhile, those who totally abstain from alcohol should consider that a man or woman who holds that drinking is "lawful" might also

be careful "not to be brought under the power" of it (1 Corinthians 5:23). So, be cautious in judging others.

Paul followed his discussion about how to walk as believers by addressing how couples are to journey together as husband and wife. Importantly, he introduced this part of his counsel by declaring Christians are to submit to one another "in the fear of God" (v. 21). In other words, Paul framed his instruction regarding marriage in the perspective of obedience to the Father.

He told wives to submit to the husband "as to the Lord ... in everything." "As to the Lord" indicates she is not required to endure abuse from her husband or to participate in things that are unholy, illegal, immoral, unethical or unsafe. This point is reinforced by Peter's encouragement that a wife's "purity and reverence"

might win over an unbelieving husband "without words" (1 Peter 3:1-2).

Meanwhile, Paul did not stop there. He did not just call for wives to submit to their husbands.

Indeed, one could argue that he placed an even higher standard on husbands to submit, calling them to imitate Christ who "gave Himself" for His Bride, the Church (v. 27). This refers to Christ's suffering cruel torture by whip and an agonizing death on the cross. Additionally in verse 26 he introduced a priestly function -- "washing" her by the water "of the Word" -- suggesting the husband is to be the priest in the home.

Finally, Paul revealed that the model for the marriage relationship is not found in Adam and Eve, but in Christ and His Bride, the Church (vv. 32-33).

-- Shield of Faith (v. 16): Shields helped defend against burning arrows, deflecting some without catching fire, and smothering the flames of others that penetrated the leather but not enough to harm the bearer. The shield of faith does likewise against the fiery darts of the devil.

-- Helmet of Salvation (v. 17): A soldier's helmet protects the brain as a vital organ. Meanwhile, the Helmet of Salvation preserves the purity of the believer's thoughts, against sin and false doctrine, as vital to a Christian's relationship with God.

-- Sword of the Spirit (v. 17): There is no more powerful weapon available to believers than the Word of God. But we must know it well to not be unwieldy with it against our spiritual foes.

Paul ended his guidance by emphasizing prayer in our relationships with saints ("perseverance and supplication" v. 18) as well as sinners ("speak boldly" the Gospel, v. 19).

Crucially, Paul's emphasis on relationships in the Book of Ephesians reflects the essential nature of our being. God stated in the beginning that He made man in His image, and that included making us a reflection of His relational nature (Father, Son, Holy Spirit; Three in One). This is intentional because before He created the universe, He desired a relationship with us. Moreover, just as He created the world to support our continuing physical existence, He also instituted relationships such as family and marriage to sustain our ongoing relational existence, too.

God maintaining a sound biblical and doctrinal basis for Christ and the advancement of His Kingdom.

"All this is a work in progress," he continued. "It is a unique approach in a very changing world. Both NBS and RABC expect to grow as we work together sharing God's property."

According to its website, NBS was founded in 1994 as a ministry of churches in the Northeast Louisiana Baptist Association. The school has grown from 30 in its first class to more than 250 students, and 37 full and part-time faculty and staff members.

Mike Holloway, president of the NBS board and pastor of Ouachita Baptist Church, West Monroe, underscored the importance of faith-

based schools in today's culture.

He added that Article XII of the Baptist Faith and Message 2000 states the importance of pursuing Christian education.

"Our prayer is that this school will help revitalize this church," he said. "We know this church plans to invest its energy to bless the school ministry. We want this to be a model for churches all across the SBC."
